### **Summary of WOMECE's participation in the 2016 December Elections**

#### ***Commonwealth Monitoring Group Discussions***

WOMECE during 2016, collaborated with some organisations and took part in advocacy and networking activities, especially directed at Ghana's general elections, before-during-and-post election activities

WOMECE held meetings with and collaborated with partners such as the Commonwealth Monitoring Group, who were in Ghana for the 2016 general elections. The Executive Director of WOMECE, Mrs Charity Binka, was involved in discussions with this group and made a presentation on the 2016 election based on a gender perspective, and also responded to questions during several meetings with this group.
